Orange Fizz

Materials:

- An Orange or lemon
- 1/2 Teaspoon Baking Soda

3. Take a bite! As you chew, it should start to bubble in your mouth

Learning Intention: Keep fit and active.

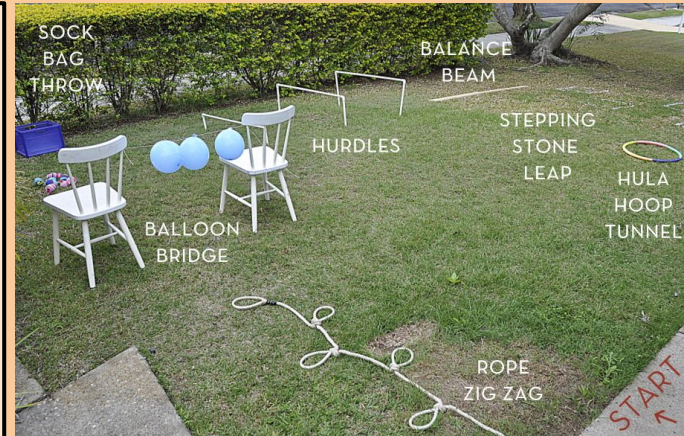
Obstacle Course
